DISPLAY SCREENS HANDY TIPS FOR STAYING HEALTHY

- SCREENS**
Take a break from your screen (short, frequent breaks are better than longer, infrequent ones). Position the screen so that the top is in line with your eyes.
- MOUSE**
Don't grip the mouse too hard. Use the elbow as well as the wrist to move the mouse around.
- CHAIR**
Change your position on a regular basis. Ensure that the small of the back is supported and that you are sitting upright.
- KEYBOARD**

SAFE WORKING WITH PORTABLE LADDERS - BEFORE USE



- Five rungs over hanging if possible
- Lashed at the top footed if not
- Fit for purpose wooden ladders not painted
- Trained persons only 1:4 angle
- Sound construction
- Warning sign and cordon off
- Check floor conditions

CORRECT FITTING OF EAR PLUG



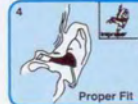
Roll plug between thumb and finger and create a cone by progressive compression with a back and forth ROLLING MOTION



When a small CRESSER FREE cylinder is formed... To a cresser free cylinder



Insert compressed portion of plug into the ear canal and hold until expanded. For easier fitting, gently pull ear outward and backward.



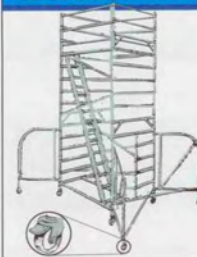
When PROPERLY INSERTED, water flange is located at outer opening of canal. Improper insertion will reduce effectiveness. Proper Fit

SAFE WORKING WITH SCAFFOLD TOWERS BEFORE USE



- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for erection, use and dismantling. Have a copy of the instruction manual available. If you hire the scaffold, the hirer ought to provide you with this information.
- The tower must be vertical and the legs should rest properly on firm, level ground.
- Lock any wheels and out riggers. Base plates provide greater stability if you do not have to move the tower.
- Provide a safe way to get to and from the work platform, e.g. internal ladders. Climbing up the outside of the tower may pull it over.
- Provide edge protection, (guard rails and toe boards) at platforms from which a person could fall more than 2m. This applies to the intermediate platforms as well as the working platforms.
